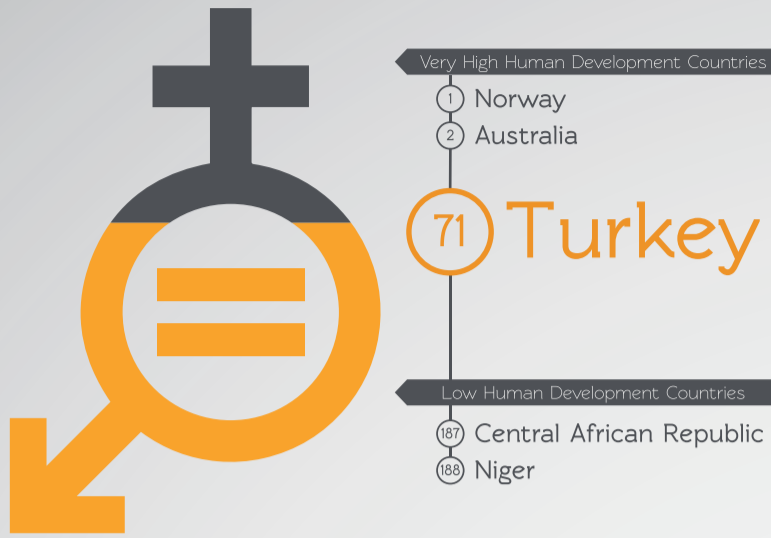


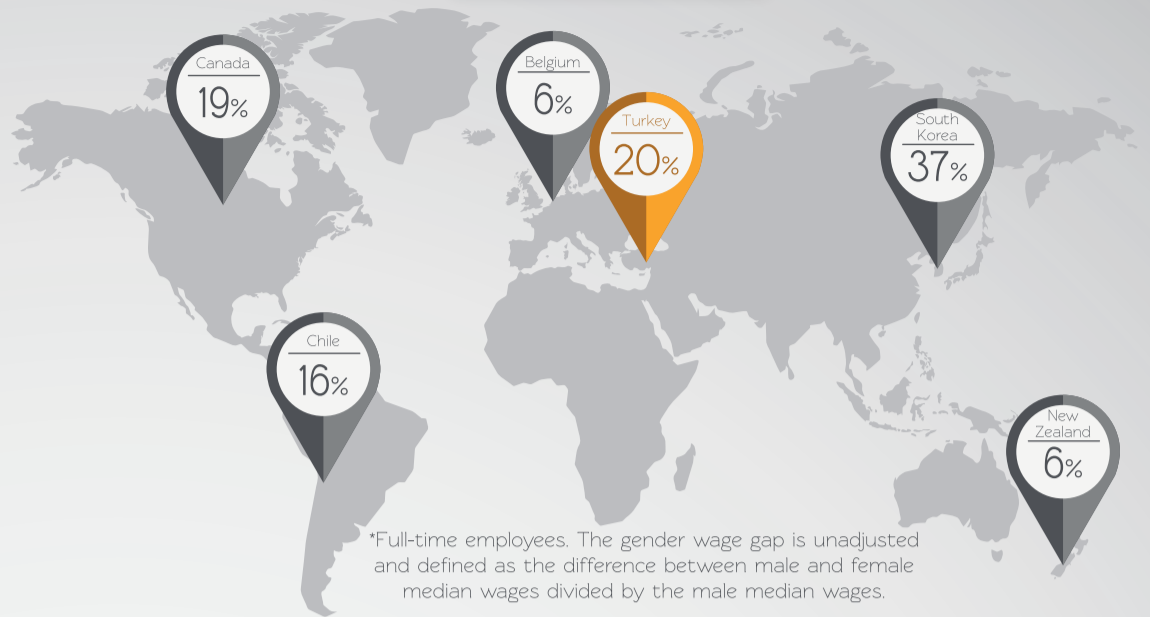

Gender Inequality Index



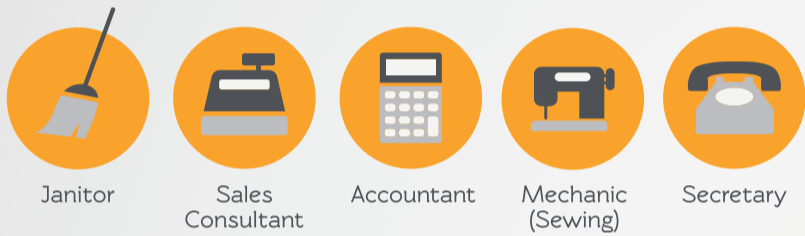

Occupations where Women are Mostly Employed in Turkey



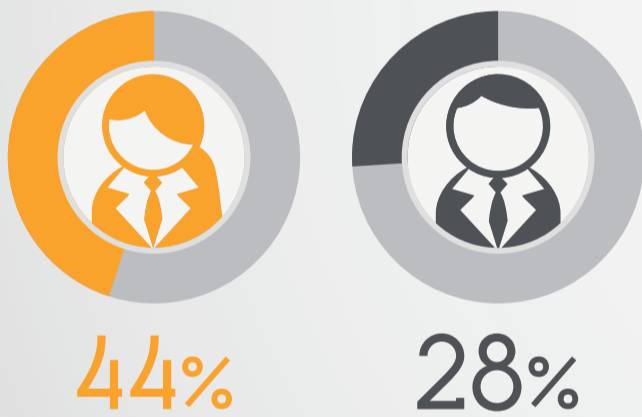

Occupations where Men are Mostly Employed in Turkey



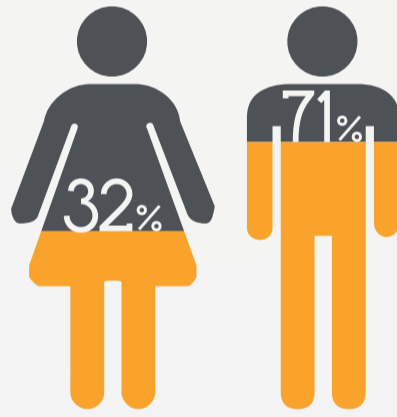

Unregistered Employment Rate in Turkey



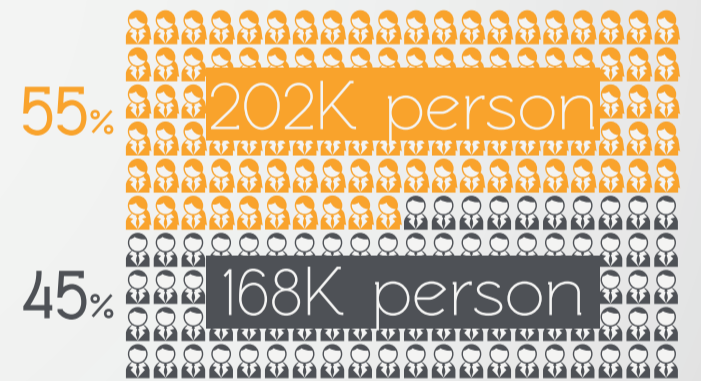
